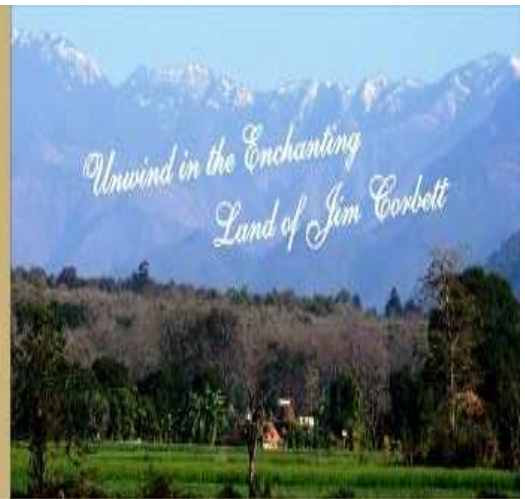

### CORBETT'S VILLAGE-CHHOTI HALDWANI

Chhoti Haldwani is a small village in the foothills of Kumaon region of Uttarakhand. This village was once owned by the famous hunter turned conservationist of British India, Jim Corbett. Popularly called as 'Carpet Sahib' by the villagers, Edward James Corbett was an Irishman, who was born and lived in India till 1947. He bought the small hamlet of 221 acres, Chhoti Haldwani in 1915 in Rs. 1500.00 from Guman Singh Barua to develop it into a model village and settled some forty tenants there. He built houses for his tenants and had a wall raised around the village to protect crops and villagers from wild animals. Corbett remained concerned about Chhoti Haldwani even after he left India.



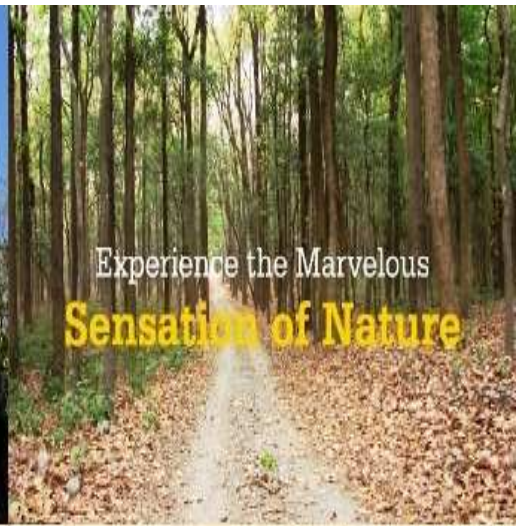

### BIRD WATCHING

From rejuvenating bird songs to exploring miles of quite untouched forests, tracking pug-marks of tiger to chasing deers in the grasslands, you will experience the beautiful effect of nature's love in vicinity of Jim Corbett's Village. There are over 1200 species of birds found in India and out of these more than 350 species are being watched in and around Jim Corbett's Village.



### JIM CORBETT HERITAGE TRAIL

Jim Corbett Heritage Trail managed and interpreted by the villagers provides a unique experience of the works done by Jim Corbett to develop a model Kumaoni village. Covering a distance of about 3.5 kms, the trail will take you approximately 2 hours. During your visit you will see Moti House, Chaupal, Muzzle-Loader Gun, Corbett Wall and Jim Corbett Museum.

### FOREST TRAILS

Dense Saal and Teak forests, winding Boar River, Spotted Deers, Sambhar Deers, Barking Deers, Elephants, Tigers, Leopards, pythons, birds at Kumaon foothills and much more... Peer into the soul and you will see nature at its purest. Enjoy trekking through dense forest, water surfing, river crossing, bicycling through forest and village roads to remote waterfalls and ancient temples.
